## 5 Financial Matters

**Budget for 2014/15 and Parish Precept** – A draft budget was presented by the clerk and items examined and queried. The Clerk was asked to contact B&NES Parks department and enquire what charges if any are made for the re-inspection of the play area. It was agreed that a surplus of income over expenditure of the order of about £1,000 was required (in addition to the extra £1,200 VAT being re-claimed this year) in order to build reserves for further Parish repair and refurbishment works envisaged in the future, there having been extensive works of the order of £8,000 in the current year.

The chairman proposed the resolution that the Precept should be set at £4,890 for the next financial year April 2014 – March 2015. This was carried unanimously.

## 6 Parish Works

- Website The clerk has not made the desired progress on this matter. It is expected that documents will be prepared and loaded in the coming two weeks. The aim is to have a lawfully compliant website by the time of the Annual Meetings. Di Frank's has written to express her unhappiness that another Parish Council Website has been created. The clerk was asked to write to her and thank her for all her work on the village website and to explain the Parish Council need for a lawfully compliant and vastly bigger site than that provided on the village website, and that it would have been wholly unreasonable for the Council to expect her to undertake this and maintain it on our behalf.
- **Two Tunnels Sound-Store device & Geology Board** Work continues on this project. The Sound Store device has been delivered and is being loaded with the sound tracks. Frank Tompson of the Two Tunnels Group is in contact with Liz Lee about the Parish track. Works are expected to be complete by the end of March. It was also reported that complaints had been received regarding access to the Two Tunnels Path at this point. The Chairman agreed to contact the Two Tunnels Committee to discuss this.
- 133 Broadband Improvements for Monkton Combe The various current developments and possible improvements for Monkton Combe village were discussed, and Cllr Des Wighton will follow up this up Rodger Sykes of Claverton Parish Council, as they have already made progress with this.

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## 7 Planning

## 134 Core Strategy and LDF

The Consultation on the Amendments to Core Strategy for Strategic Site Allocations, Site and Green Belt Boundaries, and Site Requirements closed on Dec. 21<sup>st</sup> 2013. The Parish Council has submitted comments. The Inspector has issued note ID/44 giving notice that the hearings will resume on March 25<sup>th</sup> 2014, with a full day set aside for the Green Belt changes at Odd Down on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> April 2014.

#### **B&NES Place making Plan**

The Parish Council has completed the Character and Landscape Assessments, and these have been compiled into an assessment summary which has been submitted to B&NES Council for inclusion in the overall Place-Making Plan. There were no sites identified for future development.

## 139 Other Planning Matters to Report

**Trialling of portable floodlights at Monkton Combe School** – The Parish Council has received correspondence and reports regarding the trialling of a portable floodlight system at Monkton Combe School. The Parish Council is very concerned about such a development. It considers such a trail to be quite unnecessary as the use of such lighting is wholly unacceptable in any of the proposed locations and at any time. The chairman will discuss this matter further with the bursar of the school.

## 8 Highways and Footpaths

- 140 Missing Barriers A36 Limpley Stoke Viaduct The Parish Council has been informed that that approval for these works is expected by March 14<sup>th</sup>, and that they would then be carried out in the following financial year.
- **Mill Lane Closure Report** Cllr. Des Wighton reported that closure is possible during the next four weeks, but that it is likely that actual closure will commence on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> January and last for about five days.
- **A36 Closure Report** It is currently reported that closure will occur between Mid March and Mid June, and nothing before 2<sup>nd</sup> March. There will be a consultation meeting before any closure takes place. In the meantime it is noted that Brassknocker Hill will be closed from 17/02/14 to 21/02/14 (7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.) for resurfacing.
- **Re-Routing of National Cycle Network down Mill Lane** It was noted that Monkton Combe School have withdrawn their support for the re-routing of the path. Cllr. Gavin Douglas will discuss this further at his meeting with the Bursar.
