		with B&NES Highways to provide narrow double yellow lines on a limited length of the road where			
		parking would obstruct access to residents driveways. The scheme has also been agreed by the residents.			
		It is due for implementation in the next financial year, probably during the summer period. The Parish			
		Council does not agree with applying Parking Restrictions using Yellow Lines in this rural lane, as they			
		consider them inappropriate and unnecessary for much of the lane, which is sufficiently wide for people to park safely.			
		It is thought that the longer term parking arises from fixed moorings arising from the lockdown
