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	907	<b>Budget for 2022/23 and Parish Precept</b> The Clerk presented a draft budget to generate a small surplus of income over expenditure for the purpose of restoring reserves to an appropriate safe level following extensive Parish Works throughout the current year. Councillors resolved unanimously to accept this budget and to therefore increase the increase the Precept to £12,236 an increase of £1,253, an average contribution of £69.04 for a Band D Household, being an increase of 8.61%, or £5.47 per household, on the previous year.

The small issue with some of the fixing brackets has been resolved. The Clerk is instructed to pay the Invoice and request the grant funding from the School. Church Drung – A purchase order for these repairs has been received from B&amp;NES Council, and the Clerk has sent a corresponding Purchase Order to our contractors. Work is anticipated shortly.</p> <p><b>Bus Shelter</b> – The Roof Repairs have been completed and the invoice paid. The West of England Combined Authority have indicated a willingness to take responsibility for the Bus Shelter. The Chair will continue to progress this matter with them.</p> <p><b>Miss Davis Garden</b> – The Winter Clearance works, and the removal of the dead Box Bushes have been completed.</p> <p><b>Grit Bins</b> – It was reported that all are full and in good condition.</p> <p><b>Tucking Mill Toads</b> – Tucking Mill Lane Road Closure – The draft of the Letter to B&amp;NES Highways supporting the principal of the closure was agreed, and the Clerk instructed to send it following the agreement of South Stoke Parish Council.</p> <p><b>Website and IT Upgrades</b> – The Clerk explained that the age of all IT equipment, software and Website was now more than 10 years old, and unsupported, and incapable of upgrade. The Parish Council agreed the £1,000 provision within the budget for the provision of suitable replacements, and instructed the Clerk to request Swan Management Services to proceed with rebuilding the Website.</p> <p><b>Village Hall</b> – Replacement Windows – The Clerk advised that the Parish Council could commission the replacement of the Village Hall windows, and would then be able to re-claim the VAT element of the cost, particularly if Community Infrastructure Levy funds were used.</p>

Reprofilng of the existing grass bank to provide tiered grass seating areas for use in association with an outdoor theatre space and installation of footpath. – The Parish Council has No Comment to make.</p> <p><b>22/04684/FUL - The Manor House , Mill Lane, Monkton Combe, Bath BA2 7HD</b> - Erection of extension to replace existing conservatory. Demolition of modern rear extension and replacement with new roofed structure with open sides. - Monkton Combe Parish Council consider that the proposal represents an improvement on what is present at the moment. However, the property is a detached historic Manor House, with some Medieval fabric remaining, within the Monkton Combe Conservation Area. It was noted and agreed that the problem arises from water running across the road from the drain that runs down the side of the road surface. The drain requires regular maintenance to prevent this from happening. It was agreed that the Chair and Vice Chair would each post an item to FixMyStreet, and the Clerk will write to Ward Councillors highlighting the issue.</p>
