Parish Sweeper – Elise Rowley has settled in well as the new Parish Sweeper and works well and conscientiously.

The Chair has had significant success in arrangements with the School, Cotswold Volunteers and Landowners in facilitating vegetation clearance in many areas and paths. The Chair also secured the services of a private contractor to clear BC62/4 down from Shaft Road to the kissing gate above the tunnel mouth where it splits into two, each going down either side of the trackbed (as per map attached), BA16/1 and BA16/2, at a cost of £327. Costs for Village Cleaning and Footpaths will be £1,568 under budget, even including this cost.

taken place are unauthorised. The homeowner is working with us to revise the works, the first submission has been found to be unacceptable and we are awaiting a revised design submission. The homeowner is receptive and eager to work with B&NES Highways to resolve this issue to everyone's satisfaction.
